

Reading -

In our reading sessions we will be exploring a range of vocabulary and their definitions and will be trying to use these words in our writing.

In our Little Wandle reading practise sessions, we will practice our phonemes and tricky words and will learn how to read with fluency and prosody (expression).

We will be asking and answering questions about fiction and non-fiction texts and will be proving how we know our answers by locating the information in the text. We will also be learning to infer information from illustrations and text.

We will continue to read a range of books within our environment and will be visiting the school library to develop our love of reading!

Wider Curriculum -

Science - Plants

We will be finding out about what plants need to grow and stay healthy and will observe how seeds grow into plants. We will also be learning about different types of tree and will be finding out the types of trees that are most common in our environment.

History - 'Flight'

We will be finding out how humans learned to fly and will be finding out about the Wright Brothers and the first successful aeroplane flight. We will also investigate how flight has changed over time.

Art - Drawing: 'Tell a story'

We will be developing our ability to tell a story through drawing. We will be creating textures, completing observational drawings, thinking about character expression and storytelling through illustrations.

Music


Our focus song this half term is 'Your Imagination'. We will be listening to and appraising music as well as learning to use pulse and pitch when performing the song ourselves.

Writing

In English lessons we will be using our class texts to create our writing opportunities.

We will be:

- writing setting descriptions, using adjectives
- Completing diary entries
- Learning about features of instructions and then using them to write a set of instructions about how to plant seeds.





Summer Term 1 School Value – Wisdom

PSHE -

In PSHE this half term, we will be focusing on relationships.

This unit aims to help children develop a deeper understanding of relationships and social interactions. It focuses on the importance of family, friendships, appropriate greetings, and recognising the roles of people who help us.

Children will learn to express feelings, recognise healthy relationships, and develop social skills that will enhance their ability to form positive connections with others.



Maths -

In Maths this half term, we will be:

- Measuring, estimating and beginning to record mass/weight and capacity and volume
- Learning how to tell time, including 'hour', 'half past', 'quarter to' and 'quarter past', and will be learning to show these times on a clock face.
- Learning to recognise the value of different denominations of coins and notes.

We will also continue to deepen our understanding of number with our 'Mastering Number' programme.

Religious Education -

This half term, children will explore what really matters to Sikhs and whether all Sikhs are the same. They will learn about the key beliefs and practices in Sikhism, such as the importance of kindness, equality, and service to others.

The unit will also explore how Sikhs are diverse, with people from different backgrounds and traditions all practicing Sikhism in their own unique ways whilst sharing common values. This will help children understand both the shared beliefs and the diversity within the Sikh community.
