



Reading –

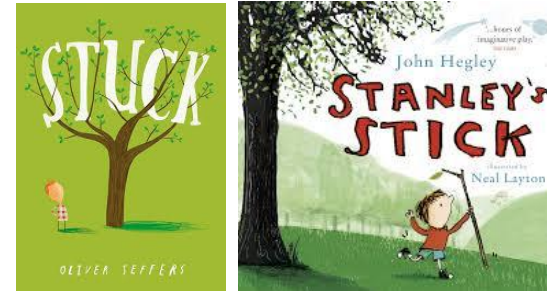
In our reading sessions we will be exploring a range of vocabulary and their definitions and will be trying to use these words in our writing.

In our Little Wandle reading practise sessions, we will practice our phonemes and tricky words and will learn how to read with fluency and prosody (expression).

We will be asking and answering questions about fiction and non-fiction texts and will be proving how we know our answers by locating the information in the text. We will also be learning to infer information from illustrations and text.

Writing -

In our English lessons we will be using our class texts to create our writing opportunities.



We will be making predictions and responding to the stories. We will also be continuing our work on dictated sentences and developing our independence in writing.

Maths –

In Maths this half term, we will be:

- Understanding the relationship between addition and subtraction.
- Interpreting and representing addition and subtraction stories.
- Exploring addition and subtraction facts within 10.

We will also deepen our understanding of number and number facts using our 'Mastering Number' programme.

Wider Curriculum –

Science

In Science the children will be learning about everyday materials and considering the question: what are everyday materials? They will consider how to group materials. Following this, the children will learn which materials are absorbent and what makes a material waterproof.

Geography

In Geography, we will explore the question: Are all capital cities the same? Within the unit we will look at the human and physical features in our local area and in London. We will then make comparisons between London and Shanghai.

DT

In DT, we will be exploring different ways of joining fabrics before creating hand puppets based upon characters from a well-known fairytale – Little Red Riding Hood. We will also be developing our technical skills of cutting, glueing, stapling and pinning.

Music

In Music, we will be discovering different musical styles using the song – 'In the Groove.' The children will learn to sing the song which has been arranged in six different styles: Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk and Funk. Each lesson we will learn a different style of groove!
